We supported Keme throughout her time at Assumption High School in Lesotho in 2015 and 2016. She has just completed her course at the Centre for Accounting Studies and has qualified as an Accounting Technician.

Keme's mother works as a house keeper in South Africa. Her family managed to pay for her to go to our partner school in Lesotho, Ha Fusi but could not afford for her to go to high school. Her brother is in primary school. Keme was the first person in her household to complete secondary school.

We supported Keme throughout high school. She was then able to progress on to the Centre for Accounting Studies without our support as the government provides free places at the centre.

Keme now hopes to find a job abroad as her course had an international focus. While she is seeking work, she encourages other young people to work hard and find scholarships. When she has a job and is financially stable she wants to help others in her community to achieve their dreams.
